

BIBLICAL SANCTIFICATION

Author's Note: The word "Sanctify" or one of its derivatives, does not have to appear in the verses for the doctrine or concept to be there.

---Definition: The word "sanctification" comes from the root word "holy" and means "set apart," "to be placed apart" or "in a state of separation."

---Sanctification is not the same as Salvation. Sanctification is only part of Salvation.

--The Old Testament speaks of things being sanctified, as the following passages show.

(Genesis 2:3 Exodus 20:8 Exodus 19:23-24 Exodus 29:43-44)

THE THREE ASPECTS OF BIBLICAL SANCTIFICATION.

1. Positional—The sanctification that every believer has as a result of what



Christ did for all believers through His death on the cross. This aspect of sanctification has to do with who we are and what we have in Christ.

(I Corinthians 1:2,30 I Corinthians 6:9-11 Hebrews 10:10, 14) 100% the word of God for every believer. The believer's position in Christ.

- 2. Progressive---The sanctification that every believer should have in his life. The process of growing spiritually according to the Word of God and under the control of the Holy Spirit (Romans 6:12-19 PRESENT Colossians 3:5-19 II Peter 3:18) The work of God in the life of a SPECT believer as he yields to the control of the Holy Spirit. The Believer's practice in life should be in accordance with his position in Christ.
- 3. **Final**—The sanctification that every believer will have when he is with Christ in heaven. The believer's practice will be in accordance with his position in Christ. (Romans 8:29 Phillipians 3: 20-21 I FUTURF Thessalonians 5:23-24 & Psalm 7:15) Will be 100% the work of ASPEC God for every believer. The Believer's glorified body is taken into account in this aspect also.
