Please read/review: GENESIS 1:13-19

- Go over verse 13 to correlate with verse 19 as God establishes the rhythm of a 24 hour day
- On day 3 God made all vegetation. If there were ions of time between days, that means there would have had to have been vegetation that lived without the sun.

Things To Consider:

1. - What came first the chicken or the egg?
2. - Everything was created with an appearance of age.
3. - Even the trees and the fruit were ready to eat.
4. - Adam and eve couldn't have been babies.

2. Earth lived without the sun and moon for 3 days... what does this say about gravitational pull?
3. What are the lights in verse 14 (*Stars*) ?
4. Does the earth always revolve around the sun?
5. Is the moon responsible for the tides?
6. God is naturally supernatural, so is it possible that what might be the rules for earth, might not be the rules for the universe?
