In preparation for our next study please read the following passages:

Acts chapters 10 and 11. Getting the gospel right. Note that the Lord does business with Peter.

Was Cornelius a Jew or Gentile? See Acts 10:1-2.

Cornelius was a God fearing man and pro-Israel (see verse 10:2). Was he saved prior to his encounter with Peter? See Acts 10:34-48 and 11:13-15.

Were the Apostles and Jewish believers pleased to hear about Cornelius?
See Acts 11:1-12.

Read Acts 11:19-30. Note that Gentiles are coming to faith in Christ (vs.20-21). What is the response of Barnabas? see verse 23. What does this motivate him to do? v. 25.

What do we know about Barnabas? see Acts 4:36

Where were believers first called Christians? v. 26.
